

Francis "Frank" Franckowiak, age 88 of Grand Rapids and Manistee, Michigan, died Thursday night, February 18, 2016 at the Grand Rapids Home for Veterans, where he has resided for the past twenty years. Frank was born on May 4, 1927 in Manistee, Michigan, son of the late Francis I. and Agnes (Sass) Franckowiak. He served in the United States Army in the Medical Supply Department during World War II from August 14, 1945 until December 8, 1946.
