

Floyd A. Patulski, age 73 of Manistee, Michigan, died Saturday morning, July 23, 2016 at his home surrounded by his family.

He was born July 7, 1943 in Ann Arbor, Michigan son of the late John and Eleanore (Majkszak) Patulski. Floyd was a graduate of Manistee High School with the Class of 1961.
