

Leonard Francis Zatarga, 98, Manistee, passed away on Monday, February 1, 2016, at the Manistee County Medical Care Facility.

He was born August 4, 1917 in Filer Township, son of the late John and Anna (Rozga) Zatarga. As a young man, he enjoyed working on his grandparents' farm, and then later was employed at Manistee Iron Works. From 1946 until his retirement in 1982, he was employed by Century Boat Company of Manistee.

He was a veteran of World War II, serving his country from October of 1942 to March of 1946. T-5 Zatarga was a truck driver and motor mechanic with Battery C, 914<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Battalion, European Theater of Operation.

Len married Rogene Baker on May 4, 1946, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manistee. They enjoyed almost 70 years of married life, first living in Stronach, then at the home in Oak Hill that Leonard completed in 1949.

Throughout his life, he was an avid vegetable gardener, and well into his 80's maintained large gardens at home as well as his daughter's farm in Free Soil. In his younger years, he enjoyed fishing, hunting, and spending time on his Uncle Stanley's "40". In retirement, he enjoyed woodworking, puttering in his yard, and part time employment with cousins Tye & Dave of Tye's Neon Signs. He loved nature, and in recent times enjoyed watching birds, especially robins.

He was a lifelong communicant of St. Joseph Catholic Church and a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Walsh Post #4499 of Manistee.
