

Martha Ann Dulinski, age 84 of Davis Street, Manistee, Michigan died Monday, January 24, 2011 in Concord, North Carolina at the Brian Cabarrus Nursing and Rehab Center after a brief illness, while residing at the home of her daughter and son in-law.
