

Frank James Gregorski age 62 of Manistee, Michigan died Wednesday, September 28, 2011 at his home in Manistee.

He was born July 15, 1949 in Manistee, Michigan and was the son of the late Walter and Bernadine (Kroll) Gregorski. Frank was a graduate of Manistee Catholic Central High School with the class of 1967. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War from April 10, 1969 until April 2, 1971.
