

Delwin “Deli” J. Hayhoe, age 82 of Manistee, MI died Monday, May 18, 2015 at West Shore Medical Center in Manistee.

He was born September 2, 1932 in Lansing, Michigan son of the late Osmund and Selma E. (Laboda) Hayhoe. He served in the United States Army as a Corporal with the 24th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Gun Battalion, during the Korean War from January 21, 1953 until January 14, 1955.
