She was the mom teachers could count on to help in the classroom. Anne loved to bake and crochet and was well known for the creative birthday cakes she made for her children and grandchildren as well as beautiful scarves, hats and afghans. She loved animals, especially dogs - they gravitated toward her and she passed on that love to her children and grandchildren.

Anne was preceded in death by her parents, her sisters Carol and Marilyn, and her brother David. Her siblings, too, died from cardiomyopathy.

Surviving are her children, her grandsons Rylan Joseph Mirretti, 8 and Jayden Cruz, 5.
