

**Robert Louis Pomerville**, age 90 of Sturgeon Bay, WI, and formerly of Manistee, MI, died Saturday evening, October 26, 2013, with family at his side.

He was born February 6, 1923, in Saginaw, MI, to the late Alfred and Lillian (Wilson) Pomerville. Bob attended school and trade school in Saginaw.
