

Floyd F. "Skip" Witkowski Jr. age 60, of Manistee, Michigan died Friday, December 21, 2012 unexpectedly at his home in Manistee.

He was born April 29, 1952 in Manistee, Michigan and was the son of the Leona (Kotecki) Witkowski and the late Floyd F. Witkowski Sr. Floyd attended Manistee Catholic Central School graduating with the class of 1971 and was a member of the 1969 State Championship Football Team, and also received Michigan All-State Honors in Football in 1970.
