The purpose of the food pantry is to respond to families and individuals who are residents of Manistee County, are low income and in need of food assistance.

Requirements: Must have proof that you are a Manistee County Resident. A picture ID, utility bill or rent receipt will be acceptable verification. You must be low income based on 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (guidelines are posted in the registration area of the food pantry).

- **The Matthew 25:35 pantry is open the 2nd Friday of each month, from 10:00 to 12:00 noon.**
- **The St. Joseph Food Pantry, Onekama is open the 4th Friday* of the month, 10:00-11:30**
- You must sign in to receive food.
- Only one person per household/residence can receive food each month.
- NO SMOKING ON CHURCH PROPERTY (including electronic cigarettes).
- No animals allowed in the building.
- Fraud, unsupervised children or rudeness will not be tolerated.
- You may attend either the Matthew 25:35 food pantry, Manistee, or the St. Joseph pantry, Onekama, during the month but **NOT BOTH DURING THE SAME MONTH. AT REGISTRATION YOU WILL RECEIVE A "LINE CARD" THAT YOU MUST BRING WITH YOU EACH TIME YOU ATTEND EITHER PANTRY. This card is good for both pantries.**
