

Rogene Marie Zatarga, age 94, passed away Monday, April 23, 2018 at Munson Healthcare Manistee Hospital. She was born October 30, 1923 in Stronach to the late Helen (Steinberg) and Frank Baker. She attended Stronach School. As a young woman, she contributed to the War Effort through employment in the WPA, and later was a seamstress at the Glen of Michigan. She spent most of her married life as a homemaker, but was also employed for a time at the Hillside Motel in Manistee.

She married Leonard Zatarga on May 4, 1946 at Saint Joseph Catholic Church in Manistee. They enjoyed nearly 70 years of marriage, first living in Stronach, then at their home in Oak Hill, until his death on February 1, 2016.

She is remembered especially for her Easter "raisin coffee cake" that she lovingly shared with family and friends for many years.
