MATTHEW 25:35 Food Pantry, Manistee 2020

The purpose of the food pantry is to respond to families and individuals who are **residents of Manistee County**, are low income and in need of food assistance. **Requirements**: Must have proof that you are a Manistee County Resident. A picture ID, utility bill or rent receipt will be acceptable verification. You must be low income based on 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (guidelines are posted in the registration area of the food pantry).

- The Matthew 25:35 pantry is open the 2nd Friday of each month, from 10:00 to 12:00 noon.
- You must sign in each month to receive food.
- Only one person per household/residence can receive food each month.
- NO SMOKING ON CHURCH PROPERTY, including electronic cigarettes (Vaping).
- No animals allowed in the building.
- Fraud, unsupervised children or rudeness will not be tolerated.
 At registration you will receive a line card. You must bring this card with you each time you attend pantry.
