

Stanley John Hendricks, age 90 of Manistee, MI, passed away on Tuesday April 6, 2021 at his home with family by his side after a tenmonth battle with leukemia.

He was born on July 12, 1930 in Detroit, Michigan, son of the late Charles and Helen (Szczepaniak) Hendricks. After attending St. John the Evangelist for elementary and middle school, then Greusel Intermediate for ninth grade, he graduated in 1949 from Cass Tech High School. Stan was a proud army veteran, having served in Korea from 1952 to 1954. He then attended the University of Detroit Mercy where he received the Doctor of Dental Surgery degree in 1959 and started his practice in East Detroit. While attending the wedding of a college classmate, he met the love of his life, Barbara Ann Bigalke whom he married in Manistee in 1960. After relocating in 1962 to

Manistee, he took over the dental practice of his brother-in-law, James Bigalke, and practiced dentistry until his retirement in 1995. Stan was a lifetime member of the Knights of Columbus Monsignor J.M. Steffes Council #853 and a devoted parishioner of Divine Mercy Parish (St. Joseph Catholic Church). He was an avid Tiger and Red Wing fan having played both sports in his youth and as a young adult. He enjoyed wine making from home grown grapes, gardening and spending time with his children, grandchildren and countless relatives.

Stan is survived by his loving wife Barb. He was a devoted father to his children: Gretchen (Patrick) Rose of Grand Haven, Mary (Dennis) Beauregard of Canton, Suzanne (Randall) Schultz of Traverse City, and John (Christina) Hendricks of Ludington. He is also survived by his grandchildren: Nicholas (Brooke), Sarah (Zachary), Nathan (Alaina), Lauren, Eric, Troy (Melanie), Taylor, Allyson, Austin, Kaylie, Cooper and Brady. Several cousins, in-laws, nieces and nephews survive him as well.
