

Gertrude J. Sowa, age 83 of Manistee, Michigan, passed away on Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at the Manistee County Medical Care Facility in Manistee after a hard battle with Parkinson's Disease.

Gertie volunteered a lot of her time helping out with the community: Five Cap, the Polish Festival, making Pączki at Manistee Catholic Central and the free Community Table Dinner's at St. Joseph Parish Center. She loved being outdoors and especially loved her kids, grandkids and great grandkids. She was a member of Divine Mercy Parish of Manistee, and a member of the St. Joseph Rosary Society.

She is survived by her kids: Mike, Yvonne, Jeannie (Edmo) and Jeff (Michelle); her grandkids: Danielle, Brandi, Karlee, Troy (Amanda) and Landin; great grandkids: Faith, Chase, Serenity & Conor; and her sisters Marilyn Perski and Vernie Kolk. Numerous nieces, nephews and cousins also survive her.
