

Dale Robert Cooper Jr., age 73 of Manistee, Michigan, died Thursday morning, June 23, 2022 at Spectrum Health Butterworth Hospital in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

He was born on June 8, 1949 in Manistee, Michigan, son of the late Dale R. and Stella (Purgiel) Cooper. Dale was a graduate of Manistee Catholic Central High School with the class of 1967. He served with the Michigan National Guard for two years. Dale was employed with the United States Postal Service for 36 years until his retirement on

July 31, 2004. After his retirement, Dale was employed as a ranger at the Manistee National Golf Course and Resort. He was a big sports enthusiast, who enjoyed watching, attending and playing sports, and was a well-known and avid University of Michigan fan.
