

Delores Bernadine (Kowalski) Klasko "Del", age 84 of Manistee, Michigan, went to her heavenly home on Tuesday, June 20, 2023.

Del was born on January 12, 1939 in Manistee, Michigan, daughter of the late Edward and Bernadine (Nowak) Kowalski. She was a graduate of St. Joseph High School with the class of 1957.
