Elaine's "Puff" Recipe (choc or vanilla)

1 c. water

½ c. oleo – 1 stick – boil; add the following;

1 c. flour

4 eggs one @ a time – spread on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake @ 400 for 35 minutes, break any bubbles that form.

Mix:

12 oz. pkg. of cream cheese

3 c. milk

3 pkg. French vanilla instant pudding. Spread on cooled crust. Top w/cool whip, Hershey syrup and nuts.
