

# MATTHEW 25:35 FOOD PANTRY, MANISTEE 2025

The purpose of the food pantry is to respond to families and individuals who are **residents of Manistee County**, are low income and in need of food assistance.

**Requirements:** You must be low income, based on 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (guidelines are listed on the application and in the registration area of the food pantry.)

- The Matthew 25:35 pantry is open the 2nd Friday of each month from 9:00 am to 11:00 am.
- **At registration you will receive a food entry line card. You must bring your food pantry line card with you each time you come to the pantry.** If you lose your card, we can replace it.
- Only one person per household/residence can receive food for the household each month.
- NO SMOKING ON CHURCH PROPERTY, including electronic cigarettes (vaping).
- No animals are allowed in the building, except for registered service animals.
- Fraud or rudeness will not be tolerated.
- Other people may pick up for you if they are listed on your application or you provide them with a written note and provide them with your card.
- **The Matthew 25:35 Food Pantry will be closed if the local schools are closed due to weather conditions. If weather permits, the pantry will be open the following day, Saturday.**
