While a quiet woman, her presence and personality always came out when someone entered the store or office that needed help.

Janet loved her garden, going to ceramic classes, playing Bingo, traveling and playing Bunko with "The Gang". She loved traveling with her late husband Lloyd on his many business or Elks bowling trips. But her most memorable were her Vegas trips with "The Gang".
