



Albert Andrew Less, 90, of Fenton, passed away Tuesday, March 28, 2026, at Maple Ridge Manor in Manistee, Michigan.

Albert was born November 27, 1935, in Flint, the son of Albert and Theresa Less.

He graduated from Davison High School in 1954, and later attended General Motors Institute in Flint, Michigan.
